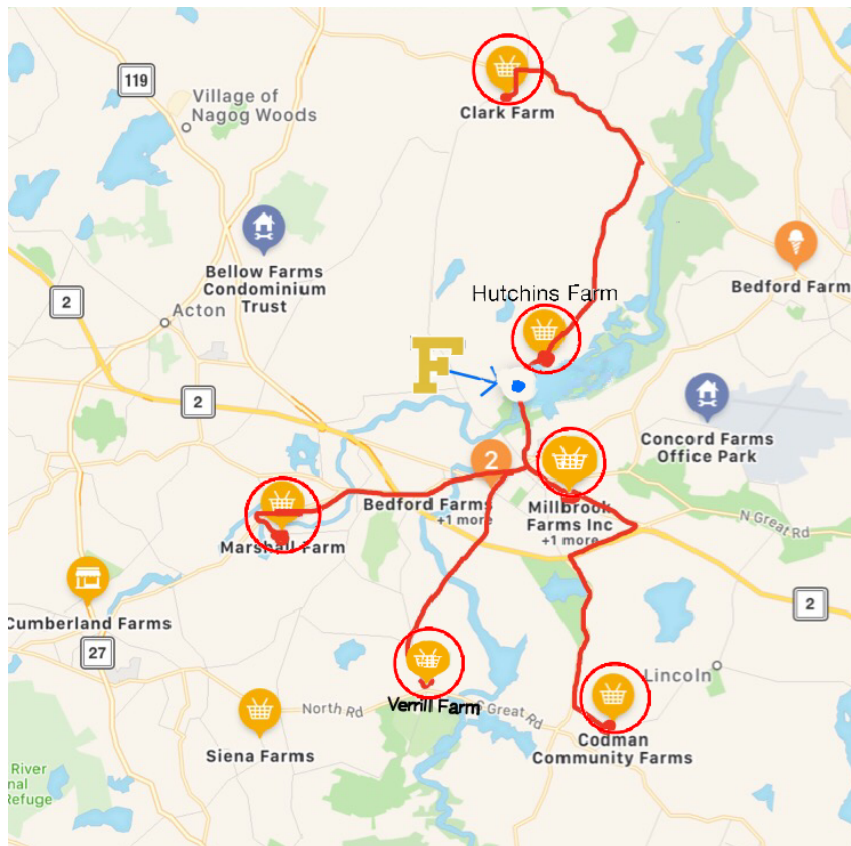

In 8th Grade Science, we have learned about food systems and the benefits of buying food from local farms instead of buying from large scale farms located far away.

- Large Scale Farms often transport their food long distances to reach a market. Air pollution is estimated to lead to 200,000 early deaths in the US
- Large scale farms are more likely to use GMOs (Genetically Modified Organisms) which have unknown risks.
- Large Scale Farms often use more pesticides and herbicides, which often seep into bodies of water as chemical run off.
- Large Scale Farms often farm mono crop, which destroys soil by draining nutrients.

By supporting small local farms, you are helping the local environment and purchasing healthier, organic, food. Know where your food comes from!
