

Guidelines for The Fenn School Chaperones

The purpose of the chaperone is to be responsible for keeping the students safe.

We recommend a 1:8 chaperone:student ratio.

Chaperones should:

- Actively supervise the boys.
- Stay focused on the students and not have in-depth or lengthy conversations with other parents.
- It is important that chaperones “spread out” and not stay together in one place.
- Chaperones must be comfortable reminding boys of appropriate Fenn behavior.
- If a boy’s parent is present and he needs to be reminded about appropriate behavior you may ask his parent if they would like to handle the situation or if they would prefer for you to.
- On any outing the boys are expected to treat each other and the chaperones with respect.
- All chaperones must have a current CORI on file with The Fenn School.
- Remind the boys at the beginning of the outing of what the behavior expectations are.
- Make sure that you have a Hold Harmless form for each boy or an electronic signature on the Hold Harmless available on the website.
- In extreme cases of inappropriate behavior and/or injury please call the student’s parent (# should be listed on the Hold Harmless form).
