

## **MARCH-APRIL CHECKLIST**

**Admissions decisions will be shared by schools on March 10<sup>th</sup>; decisions that are sent by mail may arrive after March 10th.**

### **Admissions Decisions:**

#### **Acceptance:**

*Acceptances will be accompanied by an invitation to attend a revisit day.*

- The revisit day is a valuable opportunity to learn about each school and its culture.
- We recommend revisiting ALL SCHOOLS that have extended an acceptance to your son.
- RSVP “Yes” immediately as revisit days do fill up.
- RSVP “No” if you will not attend.

#### **Wait List:**

- Contact the school’s admission office immediately if you would like to stay on its wait list.
- If your son is interested in remaining on a wait list, he should write a letter to the Director of Admissions as well as to anyone else in the admissions office with whom he interacted.
- Schools that go to their wait lists will typically do so around mid-April.

#### **Deny:**

*If you have questions about a decision, feel free to contact the Secondary School Counseling Office.*

### **Financial Aid:**

Financial Aid decisions are made based on documented family needs and a school’s available budget. If you receive a Financial Aid award that you feel does not meet your full need, it is appropriate to contact the school to discuss whether they can adjust the award package.

### **Communication:**

Please let ALL schools know of your decisions as soon as you make them.
