

## **WAIT LIST CHECKLIST**

If you have been placed on a school's wait list and are still interested in the school, we suggest you take the following steps:

- It makes very good sense for you to write a personal letter to the school(s) where you wish to remain on the wait list.
- You can discuss what you liked about the culture and the school community or specific programs that interested you.
- You may want to update schools on your recent activities and academic progress at Fenn.
- If one of these schools is your top choice, please mention that in your correspondence.
- You may send the letter by email or regular mail.

Please remember that schools need to complete their revisit days and then wait to hear from admitted students about whether they will enroll for next year before possibly moving to their wait lists.

We at Fenn will stay actively engaged with independent schools later in March and in early April to advocate for candidates on wait lists. We will be asking about the likelihood of wait list movement and will send academic updates and other updates to schools if they request them.
